


## Konica Minolta: Mobile Print – PageScope Mobile, AirPrint, and Mopria


### Section 1, Part 1: PageScope Mobile Registration (Both iOS and Android Compatible)

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Connect to Wi-Fi in settings on mobile device. **Note: Must be on the same Wi-Fi as printer.**</li> <li>2. Install PageScope Mobile application.</li> </ol>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3. Display QR code on copier/printer. Go to <b>Utility → Device Information → QR Code Display</b>.</li> </ol>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4. Register Printer with PageScope Mobile on mobile device. Go to <b>Select Printer → Add Printer → QR Code</b> and scan QR Code             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This can also be done automatically or manually.</li> </ul> </li> <li>5. Printer should appear, select <b>Add</b>.</li> </ol>	




### Section 1, Part 2: PageScope Mobile Use


1. Display photo or documents to print by selecting **My Documents** in PageScope Mobile.
2. Select document and the icon at the bottom of the screen. Select **Print**.



3. Make sure the correct printer is selected.
  - If change is needed, click on the current printer, to select a different one from the list.





4. Change Print Settings as needed by scrolling down.
5. Select **Print**.




**Section 2: AirPrint (iOS Devices)**

**\*\*Note:** AirPrint must be enabled on the machine. Go to **Utility** → Log in as **Administrator** → **Network** → **AirPrint Settings** → Turn ON **Print Settings** and **Scan Settings**



<p><b>1. Connect to Wi-Fi in settings on mobile device.</b>  <b>**Note:</b> must be on same Wi-Fi as printer. <b>**</b></p>	
<p><b>2. Pull up photo or document and select the icon in the lower left corner.</b></p> <p><b>3. Scroll and select <b>Print</b>.</b></p> <p><b>4. Make sure the Printer is correct.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If the mobile phone and printer are connected to the same Wi-Fi, it should appear.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>5. Change Paper Size and number of copies if needed.</b></p> <p><b>6. Press <b>Print</b>.</b></p>	

**Section 3, Part 1: Mopria Registration (Android 4.4 and newer devices)**

**\*\*Note:** Mopria must be enabled on the machine. Go to **Utility** → Log in as **Administrator** → **Network** → **Mopria Settings** → Turn ON **Print Settings** and **Scan Settings**

<p>1. Connect to Wi-Fi in settings on mobile device.  <b>**Note:</b> Must be on same Wi-Fi as printer.<b>**</b></p>		
<p>2. Install the Mopria application.</p>		
<p>3. Enable Mopria. Go to <b>Settings</b> → <b>Printing</b> → <b>Mopria Print Service</b> → Turn On</p>		

**Section 3, Part 2: Mopria Use (Android 4.4 and newer devices)**

<p>1. Display photo or document to print.</p>	
<p>2. Select the three dots in the lower right corner and select <b>Print</b>.</p>	
<p>3. In upper left corner, make sure the correct printer is selected from the dropdown list.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If the mobile phone and printer are connected to the same Wi-Fi, it should appear.</li> </ul>	
<p>4. Change Print Settings and number of copies as needed by selecting the down arrow.</p> <p>5. Select the teal <b>Print icon</b> to Print.</p>
