FP Postage Payment Options

FP customers have several options to purchase postage, most with no fees.

How Postage Payments Work

- 1. Purchase postage using one of the seven available methods.
- 2. FP adds the funds to your USPS postage account.
- 3. You download funds to your postage meter.

Postage Payment Methods

Payment Method 1 & 2: Direct Debit by Reset Debit or Debit-on-Demand

- **1. Debit-on-Demand:** Login to MyOneFP and choose Purchase Postage by Debit On Demand to transferred funds from your checking account to your USPS postage account
- **2. Reset Debit:** Whenever you need postage, perform a Reset (Teleset) on your meter to have funds withdrawn directly and available for printing postage

Payment Method 3: ACH/Wire Transfer

3. To pay for postage by ACH/Wire Transfer, download Pay Postage by ACH or Wire Transfer form from fpusa.com/support with the Citibank routing number to transfer funds to your USPS postage account

Payment Methods 4 & 5: Mail-In Check

- 4. Mail-In a check by First Class Mail
- **5.** Mail-In a check by Overnight Mail

Payment Method 6: Credit Card

6. Select Credit Card as your payment method when logged into MyOneFP, then enter the requested information.

Payment Method 7: E-Check

7. E-Check Select E-Check as your payment method when logged into MyOneFP, then enter the requested information
