

Canon imageRUNNER 1435iF/1435i: Registering an Address from the Remote User Interface.


Destinations can be added or edited in the Address Book via the copier/printer but for ease of use, access the Address Book using the Remote User Interface.

- Open a browser on your computer and enter the IP address of your Canon imageRUNNER.
- Log in if necessary. Select
 System Manager Mode and Log in.

NOTE: Registering or editing the address book requires the System Manager Mode level log in.

3. Select the **Address Book** link on the right-hand side of the screen.

 Note: You can also register destinations in the coded dial list.
 In that case, select Coded Dial instead of One-Touch.



Note:

OneTouch registrations are accessed by pressing the numbers buttons on the number pad 01 to 19 on the copier.

Coded Dialed registrations are accessed by entering the coded number in the coded dial field on the copier starting with 001.

 Register a destination by clicking the corresponding text link under Number, Type, or Name next to an unregistered link.




Dial Pad buttons to enter One touch addresses

Note:

Edit a registered destination by clicking the corresponding text link under **Number**, **Type**, or **Name** and click **Edit**.

Delete a registered destination by clicking **Delete**.

Select the **Destination Type**, either **Fax** or **E-Mail** and click **OK**.
